1. Discussion and Public Comment on Proposed 2024 Medical Fee Schedule

Title 85A O.S. § 50(H)(1) states the Commission shall conduct a review of the Fee Schedule every two years. The Commission contracted with an external consultant to prepare a report on the current Fee Schedule and to provide data to help the Commission develop a proposed 2022 Fee Schedule. The Commission provided a thirty-day comment period from February 26, 2024, to March 14, 2024, and solicited written comments from the public via feeschedule@wcc.ok.gov.

The Commission will discuss the draft Proposed 2024 Medical Fee Schedule and report and will also hear public comments. Representatives of the consultant, FAIR Health, may be recognized to share additional information with the Commission and members of the public, including draft Fee Schedule methodology, data points, or trends.
